

ALE DISTINGUISHED SCHOLAR AWARD INFORMATION

This award recognizes an ALE member for their contribution to the field of leadership education through their scholarship. This may include various forms of publication, presentations, and other scholarly works that advance leadership education research, teaching, and practice.

Eligibility: Nominees must meet the following eligibility criteria.

1. Applicants must be ALE members in good standing at time of award application submission.
1. Applicants may not have already received the award.
2. Applicants must have a letter of recommendation from another ALE member.
3. Applicants must have made a significant contribution to leadership teaching, research, and practice through their scholarship.

Application Form: This application should be submitted in the form of a self-nomination letter (2 pages maximum), Curriculum Vitae, and letter of reference from another ALE member.

Self-nomination letter should address the following criteria:

1. An overview of applicant's scholarly contributions that advance leadership education research, teaching, and practice
2. *Optional:* Connection of this applicant's work to the National Leadership Education Research Agenda (<http://leadershipeducators.org/ResearchAgenda>)

The letter of reference should provide support by addressing:

1. Nature of relationship to applicant
2. Reflection on applicant's scholarly contributions that advance leadership education research, teaching, and practice
3. Other relevant information

Please include a 2 page Curriculum Vitae highlighting most recent publications and presentations.

Selection: One recipient will be selected by the ALE Awards and Recognition Committee.

Presentation: Award will consist of a recognition item (determined by the committee) and recognition at the annual Conference.

All applications due by 11:59 pm, EST, Friday, April 21, 2017.
